Consequently, in the coming days, the company will ask you to provide your personal email addresses so that it can send you the documents required following this call: it is very important to provide this information.

Regarding office staff: the process will be carried out through job postings and assigned based on seniority. The positions that will be posted are positions covered by the Bell Office Staff and Related Group Collective Agreement.
